INFORMATION LETTER

Dear Colleagues,

We are pleased to invite you to participate in the V International Scientific and Practical Conference dedicated to the Day of Science, «**Science and Education in the Research of Young Scientists**», which will be held **on May 16, 2024**, at H.S. Skovoroda Kharkiv National Pedagogical University.

Areas:

1. Concept of successful education in the conditions of distance and blended learning.
2. Educational discourses in the training of future specialists.
3. Modern trends in the development of natural sciences.
4. Mathematical studies.
5. Psychology of the young scientist's career success.
6. Relevant issues in modern philological science.
7. Information technologies and information support for scientific activities.
8. Health preservation issues and implementation of health-preserving technologies in education.
9. Modern historical discourses.
10. The role of young scientists in the formation of the corporate culture of the scientific community.

Participation: Remote (presentation with slides, publication)

Languages: Ukrainian, English.

Conditions: In order to participate in the conference, by May 6, 2024, you need to send the following documents (marked «Conference») to the email address nauka.hnpu@gmail.com:

1. Application form (the form is attached) (no more than 2 authors).
2. Theses of the report (2 full pages) in electronic form, prepared according to the requirements of the conference.

In the application form, first (bachelor's) and second (master's) level education applicants provide information about their scientific supervisors. Abstracts may be submitted in collaboration with scientific supervisors.

The authors bear full responsibility for the content of the publication.

Financial conditions: participation in the conference is free of charge.

The collection will be published in electronic format and posted in the electronic repository of H.S. Skovoroda Kharkiv National Pedagogical University <http://dspace.hnpu.edu.ua/> no later than June 1.

Participants will receive electronic certificates after the conference results are announced.

Requirements for formatting materials:

- The length of the abstract (Thesis of the report) should be 2 **full** pages of A4 format.
- The font used should be Times New Roman, with a font size of 14.
- The line spacing should be 1.5.
- The paragraph indentation should be 1.0 cm.
- The margins on all sides should be 2.0 cm.
- Page numbering should not be used.
- The first line should indicate the direction (area) of the conference in the top left corner.
- The next line (centered) should be the title of the presentation in uppercase bold font.
- The next line (centered) should contain the author's (authors') initials and last name, educational level or academic degree, and academic title (no more than two per presentation).
- The next line (centered) should be the full name of the educational institution or organization.
- The next line (centered) should be the city.
- The next line should be empty.
- The next line (justified) should contain the text of the abstract (in-text references to sources used should be enclosed in square brackets, for example, [3, p. 56], where the first number indicates the ordinal number in the list of sources used, and the second number indicates the page number).

- The next line should be «List of References» (centered, in bold). The list of sources used should be provided in alphabetical order.

Formatting of literary sources is carried out according to the DSTU 8302: 2015 standard (http://knmu.kharkov.ua/attachments/3659_8302-2015.PDF).

When typing text, the following general norms should be observed:

- differentiate the dash (–) and the hyphen (-);
- do not use tabulation;
- do not use forced line breaks, do not archive, do not impose a ban on editing;
- put only one space between words;
- combine initials and surnames (S. Babych) and letters, symbols, and numbers denoting volumes, parts, numbers, and pages (Vol. 5; Part 2; No. 14; P. 24–9) with a non-breaking space (simultaneously pressing the Ctrl + Shift + Space keys); use digits and letters to indicate dates (2021, 1941–1945, XIX–XX centuries);

- use double quotation marks («»);

- the apostrophe should look like this: «'».

- The name of the file with the abstracts should be in the following format:

Makitrenko_tezy.

- The name of the file with the application: Makitrenko_zayavka.

- The subject of the letter: conference.

The abstracts should reflect the relevance of the topic, presentation of the problem content, and general conclusions. The authors are responsible for the accuracy of the presented facts, quotations, and references. The editorial board **will not consider** abstracts that do not meet the above requirements or are submitted after the final submission deadline and reserves the right to select materials for publication in the collection. Materials that are not included in the program will not be returned.
